### Item Summary

This item is to approve City Contract No. 2020-162 with Arizona Public Service, Inc. (APS), for replacing two existing utility poles with new self-supporting poles. The existing poles are near the end of their service life and have support anchors which are in conflict with portions of the new Water Production Facility improvements. The cost for removal of the exiting poles, replacement with new self-supporting poles and transferring all pole mounted gear is \$106,993.91.

### Background

WaterWorks Engineers is currently finalizing the design of the new City of Prescott Water Production Facility in the Town of Chino Valley. The design includes working with APS to upgrade the existing electric facility to feed the new production facility and abandoning and removing portions of the existing electrical facilities that will no longer be needed.

This first contract with APS is to replace two existing utility poles in locations where they are conflicting with the new improvements. This activity is being accelerated ahead of the other electrical improvements due to long lead times with new self-supporting poles.

Additional improvements by APS will be forthcoming to finish the overall upgrade on the electrical system to serve the new production facility and to abandon/remove the old electrical system which is will no longer be needed.

### Financial Impact

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Funding for this contract in the amount of \$106,993.91 is budgeted and available in the Water Fund.
