

**JOINT FUNDING AGREEMENT
FOR AN INVESTIGATION OF WATER RESOURCES
IN ARIZONA
BETWEEN THE U.S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY
AND THE CITY OF PRESCOTT
Amendment No. 3
August 16, 2019**

The Joint Funding Agreement 17CMAZ00500 between the U.S. Geological Survey and The City of Prescott ending March 31, 2020, is hereby amended as follows:

1. Paragraph 2. (a) of the Joint Funding Agreement is hereby increased from \$54,902 TO \$127,902. This Amendment reflects an increase of \$73,000 from the USGS Cooperative Matching Funds in support of the geochemistry work in the Big Chino Sub-basin.
2. All other provisions of the Joint Funding Agreement remain unchanged.
